- Design elements (Line)

KEY PURPOSE

The Line worksheet will strengthen students' ability to respond critically to visual and aural texts and develop the ability to compare, contrast and synthesise meanings.

TEACHING AND LEARNING

Words such as tone, line, shape, colour and texture are used in many contexts. It may not be immediately apparent what these words and associated concepts have in common across different domains, such as The Arts and English. Making connections between them can develop students' design awareness.

THIS INVOLVES TEACHERS:

- showing the line animation and line frames of this resource
- encouraging class discussion about the various qualities of line
- guiding class discussion about the ways line can be used in text or works of art
- encouraging students to share their responses and explain or justify their choice of language
- assisting students to complete the Line worksheet.

THIS INVOLVES STUDENTS:

- completing activity 1 in the Line worksheet, using a thesaurus where necessary
- completing activity 2 in the Line worksheet.
